school FEES

Fees are to be paid for 12 (twelve) months from Baishakh to Chaitra. Admission fees will not be charged to students who were enrolled in the previous year. However, annual fees will be charged to all the students.

Tuition fees are collected from Monday to Friday. Bills are usually to be paid before the 15th of the running month. If the bills are not cleared by the 15th, a fine of Rs.1/- (One Rupee) will be charged per day. Or, if a student fails to pay the fees for the three consecutive months, his/her name will be eliminated from the school register. The bill must be presented at the time of making the payment.

admission **ELIGIBILITY**
